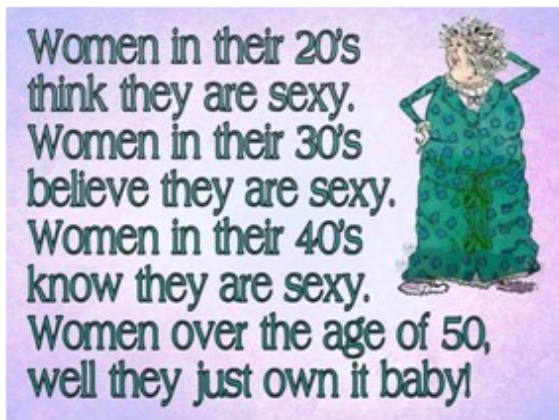
THANK YOU

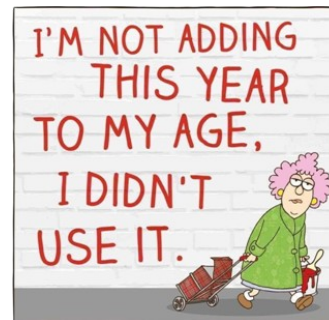

everyone that will listen it was a 30 foot putt! No way!

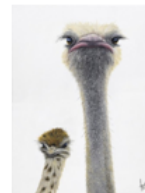
